Key Factors:

Child-Related Expenses:

Covers costs like health insurance, education, and childcare.

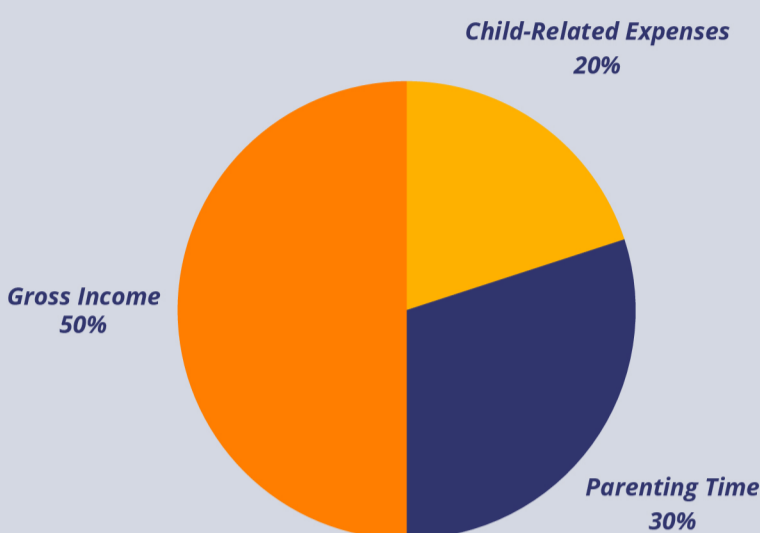
Parenting Time:

The amount of time each parent spends with the child affects support amounts.

Gross Income:

Includes wages, bonuses, and other earnings from both parents.

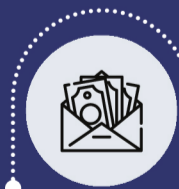
