

DUI Sentencing Chart

Arizona DUI Penalties by Offense Level

Use this chart as a quick reference to understand the penalties associated with different DUI charges in Arizona. Penalties may vary based on case details, but this guide outlines the minimum statutory requirements.



Offense Level	Jail Time	Fines & Fees	License Suspension	Ignition Interlock
Standard DUI (1st)	Minimum 10 days (1 day served)	Approx. \$1,500+	90 days	6-12 months
Standard DUI (2nd)	Minimum 90 days	Approx. \$3,000+	1 year	12-18 months
Extreme DUI (1st)	Minimum 30 days	Approx. \$2,500+	90 days	12 months
Extreme DUI (2nd)	Minimum 120 days	Approx. \$3,250+	1 year	18+ months
Super Extreme DUI	Minimum 45 days	Approx. \$3,000- \$3,500	90 days to 1 year	18-24 months
Aggravated DUI (Felony)	4 months to 2+ years (prison)	Varies - \$4,000+	1 year revocation or more	24+ months

Additional Notes:

Interlock device is typically required for all DUI convictions.

Community service, alcohol education, and probation may also be part of sentencing.

Penalties are harsher for commercial drivers, high BAC, or minors in the vehicle.
